### TREELINES TRACK

*Conceived by artist Janet Laurence, the Treelines Track is a passage of trees planted in the style of a linear arboretum. This three kilometre walking track connects the natural bushland to the farmland and Homestead garden and on to the new regenerated zone at Bundanon, weaving a connection between old and new concepts of landscape. Treelines Track was created with support from Landcare Australia and is dedicated to the memory of Yvonne Boyd (1920-2013).*
